Children's Health Services requires all newborn babies to receive a Vitamin K injection as well as participate in the newborn lab screening. Both are offered while delivering in the hospital in which our providers are happy to discuss at that time. Should you decide not to deliver your child at a medical facility, information to obtain these can be provided if you wish for your newborn to receive care from Children's Health Services. We believe these are vital aspects of your newborn care as they prevent lifelong illnesses that could potentially result in fatality. If you decline your child will not be able to establish care at our office until the age of six months.
